

## Treat Cup with a Dial Opening

I love how you are able to remove the objects from the Sweet Treat Cup without destroying the card.

This card was demonstrated by Donna Griffith at the 2010 Phoenix Regional and this is my take on it.

**Stamp Set:** Inspired by Nature, Vintage Labels, Something Sweet

**Card Stock:** Tempting Turquoise Card Stock:

5 ½" x 8 ½" – folded

1 ¾" x 5 ½"

4 ¼" x 5 ½"

Whisper White Card Stock:

4 ¼" Circle

Scraps or 2" x 5" to stamp petals

**Inks:** Old Olive, Crushed Curry, Tempting Turquoise

**Accessories:** Treat Cup, Circle Scissor Plus, Fiskars Personal Paper Trimmer, Paper Piercer, Mat Pack, Sticky Strip, 1 ¾" Circle Punch, Paper Snips, 18" – 5/8" Old Olive Satin Ribbon, Silver Mini Brad, Snail, Mini Glue Dots



### Instructions:

Fold a piece of 8 ½" x 5 ½" Tempting Turquoise in half.



From the fold line, measure ¾" down and make a slit from ½" from the bottom to a ½" from the top. OR from ½" to 5".



Cut out a 4 ¼" circle using the Circle Scissor Plus.

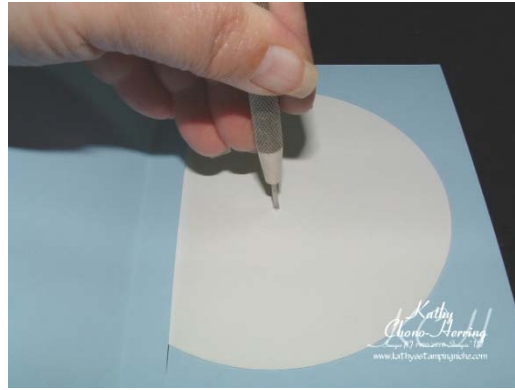


Punch a hole in the center of the circle. I actually cut out 2 circles and folded one in half and then in half the other way. Perfect center.

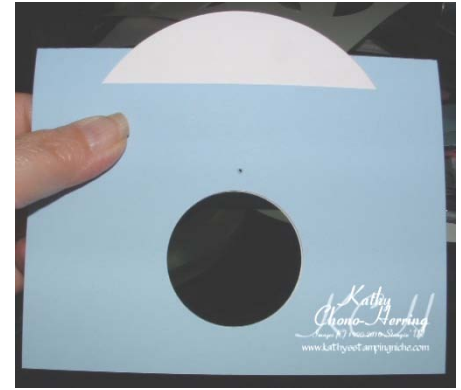

Place the 1 3/4" Circle Punch snug against the front of the card, center both ways and punch. Now add the Whisper White Circle, be sure the circle covers the front hole and is center in the slit. Now punch the circle.



Punch a hole in the front of the card using the center hole in the WW Circle as a guide.



Here's what the front your card should look like.

Align your 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" Tempting Turquoise CS on the inside and punch the same circle out. Set aside.

Now stamp the WW Circle and the front of your card as desired.



Place pieces of Sticky Strip around the outside edge of the treat cup. Do NOT remove the white liner. Remove the red liner and put the treat cup in place.



Secure the WW Circle with a silver brad from the front.

Now place the 5 1/2" x 1 3/4" Tempting Turquoise CS on the top edge of the inside front piece. Put tape on the top edge ONLY.



Take the quarter sheet that you punched a circle in and adhere it to the back of the inside front. Put adhesive ONLY at the top and in the bottom corners.



Stamp 12 petals in Crush Curry Ink on Whisper White Card Stock and cut out.

Adhere 6 of them with a Mini Glue Dot with approx. ¼" between them. Now glue the rest of the petals with either a Mini Glue Dot or Stampin' Dimensionals.



Tie the Satin Ribbon around the front of the card.

Dial the Whisper White Circle so the back is open and fill with your choice of candy or confetti or even money! Dial it closed and your Treat Cup card is ready to send!
